This camp offers a relaxed and enjoyable environment for children to experience performing and being "on stage." They will learn songs from popular children's movies such as *Zip-A Dee-Doo-Dah*, *Hakuna Matata*, and *Supercalifragilisticexpealidocious* and several others. In addition to the music, students will be taught simple movement to accompany the songs. Narrators will be used to set the scene as it appears in the context of the film.
