#### Voice and Drama Camp,

featuring music from "The Music Man"

For students entering grades 4 – 9

This camp has the largest number of experienced faculty per child of any theatre or music camp in the area! This exciting week of music, dance and drama will provide students the opportunity to work on music and scenes from the popular Broadway show, "The Music Man." They will enjoy singing the tuneful and memorable songs from the musical including "Seventy-Six Trombones", "The Wells Fargo Wagon", "Gary, Indiana" and "Goodnight My Someone." In addition to singing in the full group, each child will receive two individual voice lessons during the week. Each day the children will be lead in imaginative group theatre games designed for increasing comfort level with the group, dramatic skills and of course fun! Every child will be given a special part and perform in either a vocal, dance or drama solo, duet or small ensemble. The week will culminate in a performance at Chambersburg's Celebrate the Arts at Old Market Day, July 16 at the Capitol Theatre in downtown Chambersburg.

#### Musical Odyssey

For children entering grades 1 – 4

There will be music and acting games, rhythm activities including a drum circle, Hand signals for scale pitches (referred to as sol-feg) will strengthen their ability to match pitch and to read music and of course songs to sing. Laughter and learning will be so intermingled it will be difficult to tell the difference. The week will end in an "Expo" to which parents and friends are invited. Campers will create programs for the performance. Video taken during the earlier days of class will be shown and "Live" performance of songs and skills learned.

#### Theatre Camps - Focus on Shakespeare

For students entering grades eight and up

These companion camps will focus on Shakespeare - considered the greatest and most influential playwright in history. His plays are still performed today in their original

form and have been the foundation of countless modern plays and Broadway musicals. The plays & scenes chosen for "Camp 1: Shakespeare Scenes will be reflected in the music chosen for Camp 2: "Shakespeare Inspired Broadway Musicals." Both Camps will perform on Saturday, July 30, 2 PM. Participants that choose both camps should plan to bring a packed lunch. Supervision will be provided during that hour.

**Camp 1: Shakespeare Scenes.** Students will have the opportunity to learn basic acting techniques such as vocal projection, diction, creative movement while working on scenes from plays such as "Taming of the Shrew", "Hamlet", "Romeo & Juliet" and "The Comedy of Errors."
