Founded in 1990, the non-profit CVSM is a member National Guild for Community Arts Education.

Our 55 highly qualified faculty members serve over 600 students per year at locations in Chambersburg, Waynesboro, Mercersburg and Hagerstown.

We offer private and group lessons in all orchestral and band instruments, voice, and theatrical techniques as well as numerous classes, workshops, summer camps and performance opportunities for students of all ages.

In addition, the school sponsors the Cumberbunds (a youth chorus), the CVSM Community Symphonic Band, the CVSM Concert Jazz Band, the CVSM Community String Orchestra, and other ensembles. Last year, more than 500 students performed in recitals, and CVSM faculty and students performed at hundreds of venues in the area.

CVSM participates in the local community with a full range of outreach programs to schools and senior centers. We also schedule numerous events and concerts throughout the year.

Scholarships are awarded based on financial need and merit. We also operate the CVSM Music Store (located on the second floor of Thomson Hall on the Wilson College campus), where all instrument sales and rentals help support the school's music education programs.
