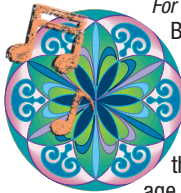

GROUP INSTRUCTION

Musical Kaleidoscope

For 4–5 years. (Class size is limited)



Building on the child's innate musical ability, this imaginative class cultivates a love of music with varied and satisfying musical experiences. The students will explore sounds vocally and instrumentally, move creatively, and listen to classical music. This class provides a musical learning environment that is fun, relaxed, and appropriate for the developmental age of the young child.

18 months–5 years. Siblings younger than 18 months may attend at no charge. (Class size limited)

Parents /caregivers participate with their children in this low-key, yet stimulating class which explores music through song, creative movement, and the use of rhythm instruments. Basic music skills will be developed as the child, parent, and teacher experience the joy of making "Music Together," setting in a motion a life-long love and participation in music.

Cumberbunds—A Children's Chorus

Grades 4–8 (unchanged voices)

In the process of learning songs at weekly rehearsals, students will receive instruction on breath control, diction, part singing, proper posture and simple choreography. They will develop musical skills as well as poise and confidence in front of an audience. The group will perform at a CVSM recital held on Dec. 16 and may perform at a limited number of community functions.

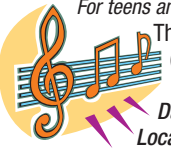

CVSM Rock Band **NEW!**

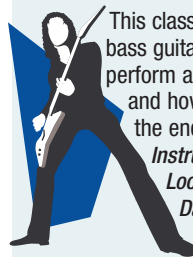
Grades 8–12
